Washers & Dryers (electric), Refrigerators, Ovens, Microwaves

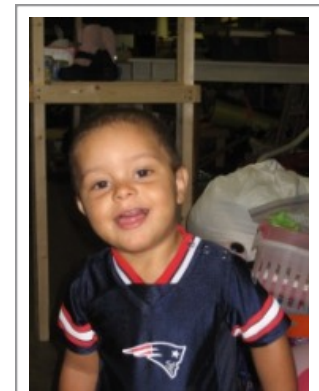


How to Make a Donation:

We accept drop-offs without an appointment during regular warehouse hours. The warehouse is located at Heritage Place, Building #2, 439 S. Union Street in Lawrence. Warehouse hours, directions, and updated information can be found on our website: www.phama.org.

Pick Ups:

We are working with *College Hunks Hauling Ju* to broaden our ability to receive donated household goods. There is a fee involved, but discount will be offered to those who mention they want their goods donated to Project Home Again. They can be reached at 1-800-586-587 or 1800JunkUSA.com. Like any donation, whatever is picked up is tax deductible.



Social workers can also pick up furniture directly for their clients. Let us know what you have to donate and we'll do our best to get it picked up if you cannot drop it off at our warehouse.

Good Night Sleep Program*

With a monetary donation of just \$70, you can buy a twin mattress set and raise a child off the floor and into a cozy bed in which to sleep. A \$40 donation will allow us to purchase a pack-n-play crib so that a baby can have a safe and comfortable place to sleep.
